Musical ability is second in consideration.

Applicants who are awarded a scholarship will be asked to provide a certain number of service hours to the Institute. This service can be completed by the scholarship recipient or their family members. Service may be completed before or during Institute.

To apply for a scholarship please complete and submit the following:

1. Completed registration form and registration fee for Utah Suzuki Harp Institute (may be submitted separately). The balance of your tuition and additional expenses will be due after scholarship notifications are made. The registration fee is non-refundable.
2. Scholarship application (below)
3. A CD/DVD of your best playing (may be submit a digital recording via email)
4. If applying for a students scholarship:
 - a) A letter of recommendation from your Suzuki teacher with information on applicant's ability, commitment to music and financial situation, and
 - b) A letter from the parent or guardian explaining the reason(s) for financial assistance (may be submitted via email to scholarships@utahsuzukiharpinstitute.com)

If applying for a teacher scholarship:

- a) A letter explaining your commitment to music and teaching, and the reasons(s) for financial assistance. (may be submitted via email to scholarships@utahsuzukiharpinstitute.com)
