## PREREQUISITES

### Major Keys

You must know all of your major keys quickly and be able to identify them easily no matter how they are presented. (e.g. If the flash card says "A" you say "3#." If the flash card says "5b" you say "Db." If the flash card shows you a key signature with no sharps or flats you say "C." Have your teacher quiz you. 15 keys in under 30" is a good reference for "quickly."

### Minor Keys

You must know all of your minor keys as well, but it's okay if it takes you a little while to figure them out. Be able to answer minor key questions presented in different ways. (e.g. If the flash card says "A" be able to tell me that the relative minor is f#. If the flash card says eb, be able to tell me that the relative major is Gb. If the flash card says 5#, be able to tell me that that is the key signature for g# minor.) Have your teacher quiz you. If you can arrive at the answers on your own without help, you're good no matter how long it takes.
